Limitations and Conditions:

1. Inspection and maintenance of the installation to be in accordance with Dart Aerospace Ltd Instructions for Continued Airworthiness ICA-D205-594, Revision 04, dated May 07, 2013, or later Transport Canada accepted revision.
2. Operation of the Bell Models 214B and 214B-1 with this modification installed must be done in accordance with Dart Aerospace Ltd. FMS-D214-594, Revision A, dated July 14, 2005, Transport Canada Approved July 19, 2005, or later Transport Canada accepted revision. In addition, for the Bell Models 214B and 214B-1 with this modification installed, operation is limited to a maximum takeoff and landing weight of 11,900 lbs. Longitudinal center of gravity limits have changed accordingly and are provided in FMS-D214-594.
3. A copy of this certificate and the FAA Approved Model List (AML) No. SR01742NY, issued January 11, 2009, amended November 4, 2013, or later FAA approved revisions, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
4. The Installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
5. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
