Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of structural provisions for four antenna pods, two on the underside of the fuselage and one each on the tips of the rotorcraft wings, per ACROHELIPRO Global Services Master Drawing List (MDL) HP 430-23-00-101, Revision "A", dated March 12, 2007, or later FAA approved revision. This modification must be maintained in accordance with the ACROHELIPRO Global Services Instructions for Continued Airworthiness HP 430-05-00-252 revision N/C, dated March 15, 2004 or later FAA accepted revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval to this change in type design applies to the above model rotorcraft only, and is limited to rotorcraft equipped with high skid gear. This provisions-only approval does not authorize any active antenna or cable installation. This approval should not be extended to rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this STC must be operated with an FAA approved copy of the Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), ACROHELIPRO Global Services Document No. FMS HP 430-23-00-301, Revision N/C, dated October 19, 2004, or later FAA approved revision. A copy of this certificate, the maintenance manual supplement and the RFMS shall be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, rendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
