Installation of fiberglass cowling in accordance with Star Valley Aeromotive Report, original issue dated January 26, 1967, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Data pertaining to this design change are considered inadequate for duplication on other airplanes. The approval of this design change is limited to Interstate S-1A airplane S/N 184 equipped with a Continental C90-8F engine and a McCauley 1A90/CF fixed pitch metal propeller in accordance with Equipment Items 101(d) and 2(b) of Aircraft Specification No. A-737, Revision 8, only. No additional modifications of this type are to be approved solely by reference to this Supplemental Type Certificate or its supporting data. 14 CFR Part 43 is adequate to insure continued airworthiness of this modification.
