*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. Additionally, this modification must be installed along with a Vortex Generator Kit per Aeronautical Testing Services STC SA5163NM, or Micro Aerodynamics STC SA4980NM or SA5668NM. A copy of the FAA Approved Flight Manual Supplement dated July 7, 1995, or later FAA approved revision, and a copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
