Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of vortex generators on the wings and tail surfaces in accordance with Drawing Package MA2156, Revision IR, dated April 18, 2001, and Installation Manual MA2157, Revision IR, dated July 3, 2001, or later FAA approved revision to either of these documents.

NOTE: If more than five vortex generators are damaged or missing, the aircraft is not airworthy.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
