This STC requires the previous or concurrent installation of a GNS 480 (CNX80) utilizing Version 2.0 or later approved software for configuration and operation of the GTX 32/33/33D Transponder. A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
