Description of the Type Design Change: Install engine baffles in accordance with Cub Crafters, Inc. Master Drawing List, MDL103800, Revision B dated August 30, 1999, and its listed data, or later Federal Aviation Administration approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

All aircraft must have the following equipment or approved modification installed to be eligible: Lycoming O-320-A, -B, -C, or -D series engine. The engine installation requires separate FAA approval if not installed as part of the original Piper type design.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
