Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the Sikorsky model rotorcraft listed on the AML. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft.
