Description of the Type Design Change: Limit the standard passenger seating configuration to 9 or less on the Sikorsky S-61N rotorcraft in accordance with Croman Corporation Drawing CCS61-9PAX-01, Revision IR, dated December 9, 2005, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. The modified rotorcraft must be operated in accordance with an FAA approved copy of Croman Corporation Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS) for Sikorsky S-61N, dated December 16, 2005, or later FAA approved revision. A copy of this Certificate and FAA approved RFMS must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the modified rotorcraft. The FAA has determined that no Instructions for Continued Airworthiness are required as no additional equipment has been installed and the existing maintenance procedures are adequate.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
