The correct Statement as follows; "ED-112A requires the use of ED-14G or RTCA DO-160G."	Comment Accepted.
ASW-170mk	Page 1, paragraph 3. titled "REQUIREMENTS"	Are we waiting for the actual release of ED-112A before we issue TSO-C124c?	Release of ED-112A could be possibly delayed or canceled.
