Description of Type Design Change:

Change battery location from dual positions in aft and forward locations to one fixed position under the oil cooler on center frame bottom tubes and installation of ballast per instructions dated 8/28/63, and Kitz Kopter drawing 1B and 2B both dated 2/29/64, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions:

1. The following placard is required: "Maximum cabin load 450 lbs. See loading schedule for ballast location."
2. FAA Approved Rotorcraft Flight Manual Revision #9 dated 9/13/63 is required.
3. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
4. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data, which is the basis for approval, shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
