Limitations and Conditions:

1. This approval is limited to the installation of the Swivel Mount assembly only. Separate specific FAA approval is required for installation of any Monitor.
2. Compatibility of this design change with previously approved modifications must be determined by the installer.
3. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
4. A copy of this certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records of the rotocraft.
