Description of Type Design Change: Installation of an Infra Red Scanner Pressure Tub in the cabin floor of Cessna Model 550 airplane S/N 550-055 in accordance with AAR Western Skyways Master Drawing List No. 84FS129, dated December 4, 1984, or later FAA approved revision. This tub is installed as an option to a smaller tub previously approved under STC No. SA1428NM. The tub mounting provisions of STC SA1428NM are a prerequisite to this installation. Further, seat tracks have been altered to facilitate installation of the new tub and are approved on FAA Form 337, dated March 1, 1985.

Limitations and Conditions: Data pertaining to this modification are considered inadequate for duplication in other aircraft. This approval is limited to the installation in Cessna model 550 aircraft, Serial Number 550-055 only. A copy of this Certificate and FAA Approved Flight Manual Supplement approved as part of STC SA1428NM shall be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
