Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to Eurocopter rotorcraft models listed above only. This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of the helicopter. A copy of this Certificate and Instruction for Continued Airworthiness must be maintained as part of the permanent record of the modified helicopter.
