This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. Aircraft modified in accordance with this supplemental type certificate must be operated in accordance with a copy of the FAA-approved Twin Commander Aircraft Flight Manual Supplement (AFMS) Document Number OAS-469-23.1581, Revision IR, dated May 18, 2007, or later FAA-approved revision. A copy of this certificate, FAA-approved AFMS, and ICA, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

*This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.*
