The approval of this change applies basically to Bell Models 206A/B/L/L-1 helicopters. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission. This determination should include consideration of significant changes in weight distribution such as an increase in the fixed disposable weight in the fuselage.
