1. Carson Services, Inc. Flight Manual Supplement No. 3, Revision 1, FAA approved February 2, 2001, to NATOPS Flight Manual for Navy Model SH-3A (Sikorsky S-61A), dated June 15, 1967 is required with this STC.
2. When used for carrying external loads, the Sikorsky S-61A must be operated according to the requirements of Part 133 (Rotorcraft External-Load Operations) of the Federal Aviation Regulations (14 CFR 133).
3. To comply with continued airworthiness requirements; maintenance and inspection procedures shall be accomplished in accordance with the following publications:
 - a. Sikorsky S-61N Maintenance Manual SA4045-80, Revision 3/15/93.
 - b. Sikorsky Equalized Inspection and Maintenance program for commercial model S61 helicopters, SA4047-13, Revision 10/15/93.
