3. Based on 14 CFR §§ 21.115 and 21.101, the certification basis for the Boeing 747-200B (2G4B) aircraft is as follows:
 - a. The type certification basis for Boeing 747-200B (2G4B) series airplanes is shown on TCDS A20WE for parts not changed or not affected by the change.
 - b. The certification basis for parts changed or affected by the change since the reference date of application, 13 July 2005, is as shown in TCDS A20WE with the exception that 25.981(a)(3) is at amendment 102 and 25.1529 is at amendment 24.

6. The item listed in Noncompliance Report, Document No G6165D.28.11, Revision NC dated 15 June 2007, must be removed/corrected before the aircraft can be returned to a standard airworthiness category.
7. When installed, airplanes with this STC are limited to operations excluding those of an Air Carrier. Specifically, no operations under 14 CFR 121, 14 CFR 129 or any foreign Air Carrier are permitted.

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
