Limitations and Conditions: You cannot use descriptive data about this design change to duplicate other products. This approval is limited to only the installation made in Canadair CL-600-2B16 (CL-604 Variant) airplane, Serial No. 5387. The installer of this STC must ensure that if the life vest has been removed with the seats that a life vest for the occupant of the medical stretcher is installed and available to the occupant. A copy of this STC must be included in the permanent records of the modified aircraft.
