This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the previously approved modifications will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. This determination should include consideration of significant changes in weight distribution such as an increase in fixed disposable weight in the fuselage.
