 - FMS807, dated June 28, 2005 for the Cessna 182P and 182Q with amphibious floats
 - FMS810, dated June 28, 2005 for the Cessna 182E through 182N with seaplane floats
 - FMS811, dated June 28, 2005 for the Cessna 182P and 182Q with seaplane floats.
2. Maintenance must be in accordance with Maintenance Manual Supplement MMS803, dated June 28, 2005 or later Transport Canada accepted revision.
3. Compatibility of this design change with previously approved modifications must be determined by the installer.
4. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use the certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
