*Description of the Type Design Change:* Installation of the Concorde RG-390E Lead Acid Battery in accordance with Helicopter Transport Services, Inc. (HTSI) Document No. HTS-LIBID-001, "Installation Drawings for Concorde Valve Regulated Lead Acid Battery P/N RG-390E," Revision IR, dated October 16, 2002, and Section 7 of Concorde's document 5-0142, "Instructions for Continued Airworthiness/Maintenance Manual Supplement Concorde Valve Regulated Lead-Acid Main Battery," Revision F, dated June 20, 2002, or later FAA approved revisions. This modification must be maintained in accordance with Concorde's document 5-0142 listed above.

*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change in type design applies to HTSI Model CH-54B rotorcraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of these models on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this Certificate and Concorde's document 5-0142 must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified rotorcraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

*This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.*
