Limitations and Conditions: Aircraft must incorporate turbosuperchargers installed in accordance with Supplemental Type Certificate No. SA4-1637. This approval of change in type design applies to the basic Piper PA-23 and PA-23-160 aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of these models on which other modifications have been made unless it has been determined that the interrelationship between these various modifications will have no adverse effect on the airworthiness of those aircraft. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
