Installation of this modification requires previous installation of STC SA36RM, or the previous installation of Lycoming O-360-A or O-360-C series engines that have been installed in accordance with STC SA-00035-NY or STC SA92NW.

Limitations and Conditions: "This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated, unless it is determine by the installer that the interrelationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications will produce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that airplane. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission. Aerial Signs of Puerto Rico, Inc. FAA Approved Airplane Flight Manual Supplement, Rev. N/C, dated December 15, 2000 or later FAA approved revision is required with this modification."
