Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of Aerocet Model 3500 or 3500L seaplane floats in accordance with Aerocet Master Drawing List No. 35-10006, Revision B, dated June 21, 1994, or later FAA approved revision.*Limitations and Conditions:* Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only, which meet the seaplane eligibility requirements defined on page 3 of this STC. The modified airplane must be operated in accordance with the FAA approved Airplane Flight Manual Supplement, dated March 15, 1995, or later FAA approved revisions. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined by the installer that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
