certifies that the change in the type design for the following product with the limitations and conditions therefore as specified hereon meets the airworthiness requirements of Part 3 of the Civil Air Regulations.

Description of the Type Design Change: Install Sensenich 80 inch diameter wood propeller model W80DM in accordance with Cub Crafters, Inc. Master Drawing List, MDL 103110, Revision new, dated May 26, 1998, and its listed data or later Federal Aviation Administration (FAA) approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: This propeller installation is limited to the above models of aircraft that have a Lycoming O-320 Series engine of 150 or 160 horse power, equipped with a fixed pitch propeller using 3/8 diameter propeller bolts via original type design, or by means of a Supplemental Type Certificate (STC) or FAA Field Approval. For proper propeller to ground clearance the aircraft must be equipped with an approved combination of wheels and tires that provides a minimum clearance between the ground and the center of the axle of 9-3/8 inches, or having extended landing gear installed per STC SA00411SE.

Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. A copy of this certificate along with the FAA-approved Cub Crafters Airplane Flight Manual Supplement No. 103110-AFM, dated August 28, 1998, or later FAA-approved revision, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
