Description of Type Design Change: Modification of the cabin interior to an all cargo configuration in accordance with FAA approved DHL Top Drawing List dated July 28, 1981. Evaluation of cargo compartment based on following equipment installed: (1) Aerospace Products heavy flooring per STC SA1961WE, (2) Brownline floor tracks Part No. 20276 per DHL Dwg. 2, (3) Fleet Air straps Part No. 47827 MC-1, (4) Brownline nets/studs Part Nos. 21530-51 and 11251, (5) Aerospace Products cockpit escape hatch, (6) fire protection liners and (7) hand held CO<sub>2</sub> fire extinguisher (5 lb).

Limitations and Conditions: DHL FAA approved Airplane Flight Manual (AFM) Supplement No. 3, dated August 20, 1981, is required and contains: (1) allowable compartment loads and floor load distributions, (2) cargo loading and tiedown procedures and (3) type and location of fire extinguisher. Data pertaining to this modification are considered inadequate for duplication in other aircraft. This approval is limited to the installation made in Beech Model H-18, Serial No. BA712-only.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
