The installation of WESCAM Low Profile Bracket Installation (HIGH) and 24", 16" or 12" WESCAM Sensor Installation-Structural Provisions Only, to be done in accordance with DECA Aviation Engineering Order No. 9703485, Revision 6 dated August 13, 2008, Transport Canada approved on August 25, 2008 or later Transport Canada approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions:

1. Operation must be in accordance with DECA Aviation Flight Manual Supplement No. 4368-01, Revision 4, Transport Canada approved August 25, 2008, or later Transport Canada approved revision.
2. Maintenance must be in accordance with DECA Aviation Instructions for Continued Airworthiness ICA 4368, Revision 1, Transport Canada accepted August 25, 2008, or later Transport Canada accepted revision.
3. Placard per Section 1.8 of Flight Manual Supplement No. 4368-01 must be installed in clear view of the pilot.
4. The eligible WESCAM sensor models are: 24" sensor model No. 104, 16" sensor model numbers: 116-DB-720, 116-DB-750, 116-SS-750, 116-8009-01(DB), 116-8010-01(16DS-W), 116-8014-01(1671-BAEA), M16DSM and 12" sensor model No. M12DS200.
5. The Installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
6. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use the certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
