Description of the Type Design Change: Installation of HUD Guidance System (HGS), Model 2800, in accordance with Flight Dynamics Installation Drawing List 9701-0868, Revision "T," dated March 29, 2000, or later FAA approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to the above model aircraft only. This approval should not be extended to other aircraft of this model on which other previously approved modifications are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any of those other previously approved modifications, including, changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that aircraft. The HGS circuit breakers must be collared and the wires connected to these circuit breakers must be capped and stowed. Line Replaceable Units (LRU) for the Overhead Unit, HGS Control Panel, HGS Computer Remote Airspeed Select Unit, Drive Electronics Unit, Combiner, Annunciator Panel, Radio Altitude Power Supply (if required by configuration), Air Data Adapter Unit (if required by configuration), Inertial Reference Unit and its Mode Select Unit must be removed from the aircraft as part of this STC. An Electromagnetic Interference and CAT II Functional Test must be performed after removal of the above LRUs for any systems which were affected by installation of this HGS "partial provisions only" STC. A copy of this Certificate must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, revoked, or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
