Description of Type Design Change:

1. Installation of Pilot and Co-pilot INGENIO Aerospace Tripod Tablet Holder Mount, in accordance with INGENIO Installation Instruction MI35149-005, Revision NC, dated January 20, 2016; and Kmlx Aviation Master Document List MDL35149002, Revision A, dated February 24, 2016; or later Transport Canada-approved revisions to these documents.
2. Aircraft is to be maintained in accordance with Kmlx Aviation Instructions for Continued Airworthiness TL35149-003, Revision B, dated May 18, 2016, or later Transport Canada-accepted revision.

Limitations and Conditions:

1. This STC approves a tripod mount for an Electronic Flight Bag (EFB) system. It does not approve the equipment for which it is intended nor the electrical wiring thereof. Installation and operational use of any Portable Electronic Device (PED) with or without EFB capability is prohibited without additional FAA approval. The FAA must evaluate the installation to ensure it complies with the applicable airworthiness regulations.
2. The installer must determine whether this design change is compatible with previously approved modifications.
3. If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter a product, the holder must give the other person written evidence of that permission.

This certificate and the supporting data which is the basis for approval shall remain in effect until surrendered, suspended, and revoked or a termination date is otherwise established by the Administrator of the Federal Aviation Administration.
