1. Deviations to Transport Canada accepted FAA STC SA01535WI-D, Installation of Garmin G1000 Integrated Avionics System and GFC 700 Automatic Flight Control System and Optional Electronic Stability and Protection.
2. No additional airworthiness limitations are imposed and the aircraft must be operated in accordance with AFMS 190-00915-02 Revision 1 or later FAA approved revision as prescribed by STC SA01535WI-D.
