This modification must be maintained in accordance with HTSI Maintenance Manual Supplement Document No. HTS-OCBICA-001, dated January 14, 2002, or later FAA-approved revision.

Limitations and Conditions: Approval of this change in type design applies to only HTSI Model CH54B rotorcraft serial numbers as listed above. Rotorcraft modified in accordance with this supplemental type certificate must be operated in accordance with an FAA-approved copy of the Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), HTSI Document for Installation of Electric Oil Cooler Blower Assembly P/N HTS-OCB-001, approved May 13, 2002, or later FAA-approved revision. A copy of this certificate, FAA-approved copy of the Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS), and Maintenance Manual must be maintained as part of the permanent record of the modified helicopter.

If the holder agrees to permit another person to use this certificate to alter the product, the holder shall give the other person written evidence of that permission.
