This approval should not be extended to other rotorcraft of this model on which other previously approved modification are incorporated unless it is determined that the relationship between this change and any other previously approved modifications, including changes in type design, will introduce no adverse effect upon the airworthiness of that rotorcraft. Modified rotorcraft must be operated in accordance with a copy of FAA-approved Rotorcraft Flight Manual Supplement (RFMS) AASI-FM-627, Revision IR, dated January 26, 2004, or later FAA-approved revision. A copy of this certificate, the RFMS, and the ICA, must be maintained as part of the permanent records for the modified aircraft.
