





This memorandum authorizes the use of FAA Order 1350.14B, *Records Management*, for the below list of orders. It voids the use of FAA Order 1350.15, *Records, Organization, Transfer, and Destruction Standards*. FAA Order 1350.14B canceled FAA Order 1350.15 on December 24, 2013.

AVS received a Corrective Action Request (CAR C-16-0231) during an audit. The Office of Quality, Integration & Executive Services (AQS) Directives Management Officer (DMO) requests that all of our orders be changed to remove the reference to FAA Order 1350.15.

It is not feasible for AIR to correct 27 orders at this time. Eight of the orders are currently undergoing revision.

A deviation is granted to use FAA Order 1350.14B in lieu of FAA Order 1350.15.
