General	Neale Eyer Ph#: 316-517-7488	Cessna Aircraft Company	Cessna Aircraft Company suggests that the FAA make AC21-50 (Installation of TSOA Articles and LODA Appliances) a part of this document to emphasize TSOA holders responsibilities in the approval process.	Not Accepted. AC 21-50 describes the use of TSO data approved by the FAA during the TSO authorization process. The guidance in AC 21-50 allows applicants seeking a type certificate, or approval of a change to a type design, to use the data generated for a TSO authorization, such as TSO-AFGCS (TSO-C198), during the TC, ATC, or STC project, when that data is applicable.
5.f	Bob Godsy	Garmin	This section is not consistent with FAA Order 8110.4C CHG 4 in regard to Non-TSO Functions. Since FAA Order 8110.4C CHG 4 contains the FAA preferred method this section needs to be re-written.	Partially Accepted. We compared the language in Order 8110.4c Change 4 and Order 8150.1b Change 1. The intent of the language is consistent, with the exception of 81104c Change 4 specifying that a feature is not a non-TSO function. TSO-AFGCS (TSO-C198) was updated to remove the word “feature.” The draft of Change 2 for Order 8150.1b is also being updated with this change.
